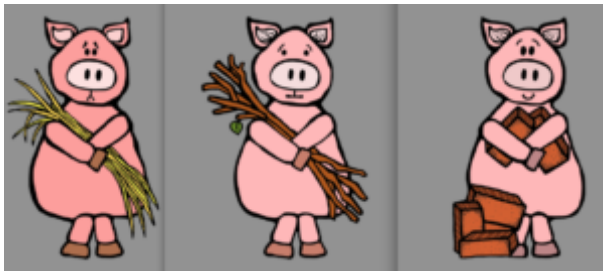


Key vocabulary

 Children to count forward and backward to 20.
