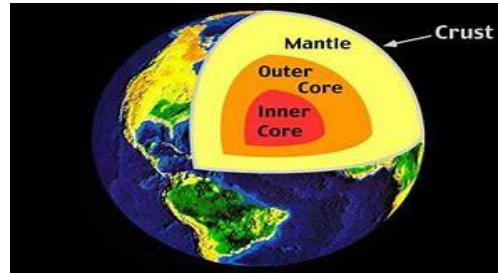


**Vocabulary**

1	Topsoil	Where plants grow their roots. There are very few rocks.
2	Bedrock	A mass of rocks such as limestone and sandstone. You might find fossils here.
3	Crust	Layer of cold rock that covers the world.
4	Mantle	Extremely hot rock that flows like treacle.
5	Outer core	It is mostly made of iron and it is over 4000 degrees C.
6	Inner core	This is the hottest layer at over 5000 degrees C.
7	Tectonic plates	Huge areas of crust that float on the mantle.
8	Volcano	Is a rupture in the crust of the earth.
9	Eruption cloud	The cloud that forms when a volcano erupts.
10	Dormant volcano	A volcano that hasn't erupted in 10,000 years.
11	Earthquake	It is the shaking of the surface of the Earth.
12	Tsunami	A Japanese word meaning 'Giant wave'.

1912	Largest volcanic eruption of the 20 <sup>th</sup> Century, in Alaska.
1960	Largest recorded earthquake occurred in Southern Chile.
2018	Tsunami in Indonesia kills 1350 people.
2018	Vietnam has had 38 earthquakes this year.
2018	Most recent large Volcanic eruption, in Hawaii.
