

Monday	<p>PE with Joe Wicks</p> <p>Available live at 9am on YouTube (The Body Coach channel)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Going for your daily exercise/walk</p>	<p>English - The Snail and the Whale</p> <p>Watch & listen to the story (YouTube - see below for link)</p> <p>Choose one of the places that the snail and the whale visit and write a diary entry as the snail about her time there.</p> 	<p>Maths - Time (daily routines)</p> <p>Thinking about your daily routine what do you do in the morning, afternoon and evening?</p> <p>Make a list of the things that you do in the morning, afternoon and evening.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When do you brush your teeth? • Do you have breakfast at nighttime? • When do you go to bed? • When do you put your pyjamas on? 	<p>Reading/Phonics</p> <p>https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/books/free-ebooks/ Select an age appropriate reading book from the free EBooks and read the beginning of the story</p> <p>https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk Phase 3, 4, 5 phonics practice games</p>	<p>Science - Materials</p> <p>I would like you to conduct an experiment to answer the following question... "What material is best to use for an umbrella?"</p> <p>I think paper would be a good idea. Am I right? (Test different materials by pouring water onto them.)</p>

<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Tuesday</p>	<p>Cosmic Kids Yoga</p> <p>Available on YouTube (Cosmic Kids Yoga channel)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Going for your daily exercise/walk</p>	<p>English - The Snail and the Whale</p> <p>Re-cap the story and what happens in the beginning, middle and end.</p> <p>In the story, the whale gets stuck on the beach. Can you write a letter to the school children asking for their help to save the whale?</p> <p>You could even draw a few pictures from the story to go with your letter.</p> <p>Remember to start your letter with "Dear..."</p>	<p>Maths - Time (game)</p> <p>Lets start thinking about the language of time.</p> <p>You may have heard the game called 'What time is it Mr Wolf?'</p> <p>I would like you to play this with your grown ups!</p> <p>You can teach them to play the game.</p> <p>See if you can use the word "o'clock" when playing the game e.g. "what time is it Mr Wolf?" "It's 6 o'clock!"</p> <p>Don't forget to have DINNER TIME and chase after your grown up.</p>	<p>Reading/Phonics</p> <p>https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/books/free-ebooks/</p> <p>Continue reading the same EBook from yesterday. Read the middle part of the story.</p> <p>https://www.phonicsbloom.com</p> <p>Phase 3, 4, 5 phonics practice games</p>	<p>Baking - Hedgehog rolls</p> <p>This week we would like you to have a go at making some yummy hedgehog bread rolls.</p>  <p>PS: if you want to you could write a list of the ingredients and the method that you used.</p>
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<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Wednesday</p>	<p>Wake Up Shake UP</p> <p>Available on YouTube (Out of the Ark Music channel)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Going for your daily exercise/walk</p>	<p>English - The Snail and the Whale</p> <p>The snail and the whale travel across the ocean to visit many places together. Can you use the ocean as the main setting and write a description about it?</p> <p>If you were in the middle of the ocean what would you see? What would you hear? Would you see other sea creatures?</p> 	<p>Maths - Time (What does a clock look like? What has it got?)</p> <p>Today I would like you to either grab some chalk and head outside or grab a piece of paper and some pencils.</p> <p>We would like you to draw what a clock looks like.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What numbers does it have on it? • What are the sticks in the middle called? (hands) • Why is there 2 or 3 of them? (hour, minute, seconds) 	<p>Reading/Phonics</p> <p>https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/books/free-ebooks/</p> <p>Continue reading the same EBook from yesterday. Read the end part of the story.</p> <p>YouTube - Phase 3,4,5 tricky word songs (Epic Phonics channel)</p>	<p>Art - ocean</p> <p>Linking to your English work, we would like you to draw, paint or make a beautiful picture of what under the sea would look like.</p> <p>Use your description to think about the colours and what you would see in the ocean.</p> 
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<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Thursday</p>	<p>GoNoodle - Trolls can't stop the feeling</p> <p>Available on YouTube (GoNoodle channel)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Going for your daily exercise/walk</p>	<p>English - The Snail and the Whale</p> <p>Imagine you were the snail in the story and you could choose a place to visit with the whale. Where would you go?</p> <p>Write a list of items you would pack in your bag to take with you, and explain why you would take them.</p> <p>Miss Maguire says she would definitely take her swimming costume!</p> 	<p>Maths - Time</p> <p>Quickly recap the features of a clock (hands & numbers)</p> <p>Today you will be learning to tell the time to the nearest o'clock and half past.</p> <p>Ask your adult to draw you a picture of a clock with some hands on it. Ask them to draw the hands on the clock to make a time e.g. 4 o'clock, half past 6. Can you guess the time they have made?</p> <p>Top Tip: encourage your child to really think about the big hand being on 12 for o'clock and 6 for half past. As an extra challenge ask your child to draw the hands for a specific time e.g. 7 o'clock.</p>	<p>Reading/Phonics</p> <p>YouTube - Phase 3,4,5 tricky word songs (Epic Phonics channel)</p> <p>Reading den - create a reading den using cushions, blankets, the duvet, chairs etc.</p> <p>Once you have made your den, choose your favourite book and get cosy inside your den.</p>	<p>History/ Geography - Christopher Columbus</p> <p>For your Topic work we would like you to start learning all about Christopher Columbus.</p> <p>But before you learn everything about him, I would first like you to learn the names of 5 oceans in the world. Can you name them all?</p>
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<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Friday</p>	<p>GoNoodle - Banana Banana Meatball</p> <p>Available on YouTube (GoNoodle channel)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Going for your daily exercise/walk</p>	<p>English - The Snail and the Whale</p> <p>Watch & listen to the story (YouTube - see links below)</p> <p>Re-cap list of items you would take with you on your adventure.</p> <p>If you could go on an adventure on the back of a whale, who would you take with you, and why?</p> <p>As well as writing about who you would take and why, we would like you to draw a picture of you and this person.</p>	<p>Maths - Time (challenge/ game)</p> <p>We would like you to put your knowledge of time to the test!</p> <p>CHALLENGE TIME!</p> <p>Your grown up will give you a time e.g. 11 o'clock (keep to o'clock and half past)</p> <p>You will have to watch the clock to keep an eye on time - it goes by fast!</p> <p>When it's the time on the clock you must SHOUT as loud as you can to your adult e.g. "IT'S 11 O'CLOCK!"</p> <p>For every time you get right you can have 5 Dojo points when you get back to school.</p>	<p>Reading/Phonics</p> <p>https://www.phonicsbloom.com</p> <p>Phase 3, 4, 5 phonics practice games</p> <p>Book review - read any story with your adult. Can you discuss your thoughts and feelings about the book?</p> <p>Did you like it? What part did you like? If you didn't like it, why?</p> <p>Rate the book out of 5 stars.</p>	<p>DT -</p> <p>Linking to your maths work this week, we would like you to make your very own clock!</p> <p>You will need a paper plate, pencils, pipe cleaners and/or split pins.</p>
