Dear Families,

During the summer holidays the Key Stage 1 kitchen was refurbished and after a few snags that led to the works over running into term time the kitchen has now been fully functional for just over a week. The work and redesign has enabled us to change the way the children are served their dinners. The children now collect a tray, select their main course and dessert from the servery and then carry their tray to the dining tables. The children have been fantastic in doing this and they tell us that it is 'like going to a restaurant'. Once they have finished, they scrape any leftovers into a bin and then go out to play. This part is proving a little trickier but our Y5 and 6 lunch monitors are there to support them. I'm so proud of the children in demonstrating such independence skills at such a young age.

On Friday your children may have come home talking about PANTS. All classes in school participated in an NSPCC lesson about keeping themselves safe. From P through to S, each letter of PANTS provides a simple but valuable lesson that can help keep a child safe: that their body belongs to them, they have a right to say no, and that they should tell an adult they trust if they're worried or upset.
