Seat Belt Safety

It has been of great concern to see some families arriving and leaving school with children not safely secured in their seats.

We have also seen some families with more than 3 children in the back of their car. **Not only is this alarming from a safety point of view, it is illegal.**

Children need to use an appropriate child restraint when travelling in the front of a car and also when travelling in the back of a car. If a child is under 1.35 metres (approx 4 feet 5 inches) tall, a baby seat, child seat, booster seat or booster cushion **MUST** be used suitable for the child's weight and fitted to the manufacturer's instructions.
